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Medi-Cal Expansion may cover meds & care if household income is at or below 138% of MAGI FPL*

- **2023 138% MAGI FPL***: household size of 1 = \$20,121/year or \$1,677/month | of 2 = \$27,214/year or \$2,269/month

CA Office of AIDS programs help cover costs for meds & care if household is between 139% – 500% MAGI FPL*

- **2022 500% FPL MAGI***: for 1 = \$67,950 | for 2 = \$91,550 | for 3 = \$115,150 | for 4 = \$148,750
- **ADAP** → tiny.cc/ADAP → covers the cost of HIV & related medications for uninsured *and* insured enrollees
- **OA-HIPP** → tiny.cc/OAHIPP → pays private insurance premiums (e.g. Covered CA, COBRA) and out-of-pocket costs
- **EB-HIPP** → tiny.cc/EBHIPP → pays the client’s portion of employer-based insurance and out-of-pocket costs
- **Medicare Part D Premium Payment** → tiny.cc/MDPP → pays Medicare Part D and MediGap plan premiums

***MAGI = Modified Adjusted Gross Income of Federal Poverty Level;**
